Sect. 4 - Information note and obtaining of consent for the purposes of processing the domain name registration details and for publishing on the Internet.

Information note pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Code (Italian Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003, Article 13).

For the purposes of performing the activities referred to in this information note:

- a) the Data Controller is the CNR, through the CNR Istituto di Informatica e Telematica [Institute of Informatics and Telematics], .it Registry (<http://www.nic.it>);
- b) the Data Supervisor is the Registrar who manages the contractual relationship with the Registrant from time to time; their identification details are contained in the contract formalized between the aforementioned Registrar and the Registrant, and as such are known to the party concerned. A list of Data Supervisors is available on the Registry's website at <http://www.nic.it>. The Registrar shall remain the Data Controller in relation to the contractual relationship entered into directly with the Registrant and not covered by the scope of this information note;
- c) mandatory information is that information essential for the performance of the service requested.

The Registrant's personal details are collected by the Registrar who manages the contractual relationship with the Registrant from time to time by way of this form, for the purposes of registering and managing the domain name in the Assigned Name Database kept at the CNR's Istituto di Informatica e Telematica, .it Registry.

In addition to the personal data collected through the completion of the form, in the event that the transaction is carried out electronically, the IP address associated with the Internet connection used by the Registrant to complete the online form and the log of the corresponding transaction will also be identified and stored, for the purposes of helping to identify the registrant in relation to the personal details declared and the other declarations made by the registrant. The personal data, the above-mentioned IP address and the transaction log shall constitute the mandatory information. The mandatory information collected will be processed for administrative and accounts management purposes, to protect rights and for other purposes and activities associated with the registration, management, disputes, transfer and cancellation of the domain name, as well as to comply with legal obligations, regulations or EU legislation, and passed on to third parties for any additional or required activities for the purposes of compliance with the above-mentioned purposes. Data will not be used or passed on to third parties for marketing or sales activities. With the exception of the IP address, the details will also be passed on to third parties who declare their intention to take action to protect their own rights against the Registrant in relation to the registration or use of the domain name.

In accordance with the technical standards of the Internet Engineering Task Force - IETF (<http://www.ietf.org>) aimed at ensuring the accessibility of the domain name on the Internet, in order to maintain the balance of the relevant system, as well as in consideration of the .it Registry policy designed to avoid situations of anonymity and to allow the traceability of assignees, if registration is completed the following details will in all cases be visible on the Internet, through Whois query, together with the domain name: name and surname of the registrant or company name, domain status, Registrar and technical data (contactID, registration date, expiry date, date of last update and nameservers).

For the purposes of this information note, consent to processing for registration purposes relates to all the above-mentioned activities, as a whole. Consent for registration purposes is optional, but if such consent is not given, it will not be possible to register, allocate or manage the domain name.

Moreover, the following details will also be visible via the Internet, subject to the provision of a separate consent, through Whois query, together with the domain name: registrant's residential address or registered office, and the Registrant's telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.

For the purposes of this information note, consent for the purposes of accessibility and distribution via the Internet relates solely to these latter activities and types of details. Consent for the purpose of accessibility and disclosure via the Internet is optional; failure to give such consent shall not prevent registration, merely public visibility via Whois queries of this data, within the limits defined above.
